Directions: Cross the Susquehanna River. Go to Front and Foster to cross using the Harvey Taylor Bridge. Stay on Route 15 until you come to Rossmoyne Road. Take this road to the stop sign and bear right. Go 1.5 miles to fork in road. Take left branch, which brings you out to lower Allen playground. Make right and go to cemetery.
