- [wikipedia article](#) [Apr 2014] Khovanskoye Cemetery is the largest cemetery in Europe, covering more than 1,970,000 m<sup>2</sup> (21,200,000 sq ft)[2] It is divided into three smaller parts:

- **Khovanskoye Central Cemetery**, which was established in 1972 and covers 877,200 m<sup>2</sup> (9,442,000 sq ft),

- **Khovanskoye Northern Cemetery**, founded in 1978 and covering 600,000 m<sup>2</sup> (6,500,000 sq ft), [gravestone photos with names and dates](#) . [Apr 2014]
